ARRESTS MADE IN THE MEMORIAL MORTUARY INVESTIGATION

Attorney General Earl I. Anzai announced that today, October 28, 2002, investigators from the Department of the Attorney General arrested Robert Diego, Momi Diego and Bobby Jean Diego on Grand Jury bench warrants issued as a result of indictments handed down by the Hilo Grand Jury on October 23, 2002. Robert Diego was arrested for Theft in the First Degree and thirty-eight (38) counts of Theft in the Second Degree. Momi Diego was arrested for Theft in the First Degree and thirty-six (36) counts of Theft in the Second Degree. Bobby Jean Diego was arrested for Theft in the First Degree and thirty-one (31) counts of Theft in the Second Degree. They were booked at the Hilo Police Department and released on bail. Arraignment and plea is set for December 3, 2002, at 8:30 a.m.
