**ATTORNEY GENERAL ANNOUNCES NUSANCE ABATEMENT ACTION
FILED AGAINST SECOND GENERATION DRUG HOUSE**

HONOLULU - Attorney General Mark Bennett announced today that the newly established Drug Nuisance Abatement Unit within his office filed its first nuisance abatement action. The complaint alleges that drugs have been distributed from 1949 Stanley Street for at least four years. The action seeks a court order to ban two of the current residents and two relatives for distributing, or tolerating the distribution of illegal drugs, including crystal methamphetamine, also known as "ice." The complaint alleges that the father of one of the current residents, who is currently serving a drug-related prison sentence, dealt drugs from the house until he was convicted and sentenced to prison, and that his sons have now taken up drug offenses. One of his sons was recently arrested for drug related felonies. Once the four individuals named in the suit are served with the complaint, they will be given 20 days to respond to the allegations.
