Extension of Filing Date for Stipulated Procedural Order

On behalf of the Division of Consumer Advocacy (“Consumer Advocate”) and Life of the Land, Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. (“HECO”) requests the Commission to extend from July 28 to August 28, 2006 the date to file a stipulated procedural order for this proceeding.

On June 15, 2006, the Commission issued Order No. 22533 which directed the parties in this proceeding (HECO, the Consumer Advocate and Life of the Land) to meet informally to determine the issues, procedures, and schedule of this proceeding and file a stipulated procedural order within 30 days of the date of the order (i.e., July 15, 2006). On July 14, 2006, HECO filed a request to extend the due date to July 28, 2006. However, due to a heavy regulatory workload, the parties need additional time to develop the stipulated procedural order and request an extension of the due date to August 28, 2006.¹
