
In the event that the requested information is not received in a timely manner, we will be recommending that the Commission suspend approval of the application pending our receipt of the requested information.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

In order to expedite and facilitate the Public Official's review and analysis in the above matter, the following is requested:

1. For each response, the Company should identify the person who is responsible for preparing the response as well as the witness who will be responsible for sponsoring the response should there be an evidentiary hearing;
2. Should the Company claim that any information is not discoverable for any reason:
  - a. State all claimed privileges and objections to disclosure;
  - b. State all facts and reasons supporting each claimed privilege and objection;
  - c. State under what conditions the Company is willing to permit disclosure to the Public Officials (e.g., protective agreement, review at business offices, etc.); and
  - d. If the Company claims that a written document or electronic file is not discoverable, besides complying with subparagraphs 2(a-c), identify each document or electronic file, or portions thereof, that the Company claims are privileged or will not be disclosed, including the title or subject matter, the date, the author(s) and the addressee(s).

Kapiolani Area Revised Sewer System Project and/or the Honolulu Board of Water Supply Kapiolani Boulevard Water Line Project.

- c. Please produce copies of all documents that describe, clarify or explain all actions that HECO may take to utilize Alternative Alignment 1, Item 3.2.2.1.1, page 3-45 in its Draft Environmental Assessment as a potential transmission line alignment.
