Pursuant to Order No. 22251, the parties/participants\* were scheduled to provide informally to each other their respective Preliminary Statement of Position ("PSOP") on February 15, 2006. The Hawaii Solar Energy Association, by email to the parties/participants, proposed a two-week extension, until March 1, 2006, for the parties/participants to informally provide their PSOPs, citing the high level of demand-side management program-related activity at the current Legislative session. All of the parties/participants supported the proposed extension. Therefore, HECO/HELCO/MECO, on behalf of the parties/participants, request Commission approval for an extension, until March 1, 2006, for the parties/participants to informally exchange their respective PSOPs.
