

## SCHEDULE OF REPORTING DATES FOR NONCANDIDATE COMMITTEES

(November, 2008)

### REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Organizational Report

The Organizational Report must be filed by a Noncandidate Committee within ten days of receiving contributions or making expenditures that amount to more than \$1,000, in the aggregate, in a two-year election period; except that within the thirty day period prior to an election, a Noncandidate Committee shall file an Organizational Report within two days of receiving contributions or making expenditures that amount to more than \$1,000, in the aggregate, in a two-year election period. The report must include the amount, name and address of each person who contributed more than \$100 since the last election for the office being sought. (HRS, Section 11-194 and 11-196.5)

**At the conclusion of the 2010 election period, Noncandidate Committees with a surplus or deficit must continue reporting with the Commission until the surplus has been disbursed or the deficit has been cleared. The first report for the 2012 election period is the Supplemental Report due on January 31, 2011, covering the period from November 3 through December 31, 2010.**

**The Noncandidate Committee may terminate its registration and reporting requirements by filing the "Request For Registration Termination" form, if the Noncandidate Committee has no surplus or deficit and the Commission approves the request.**
