REGISTRATION

Organizational Report

The Organizational Report must be filed by a Noncandidate Committee within ten days of receiving contributions or making expenditures that amount to more than \$1,000, in the aggregate, in a two-year election period; except that within the thirty day period prior to an election, a Noncandidate Committee shall file an Organizational Report within two days of receiving contributions or making expenditures that amount to more than \$1,000, in the aggregate, in a two-year election period. The report must include the amount, name and address of each person who contributed more than \$100 since the last election for the office being sought.

<input type="checkbox"/> December 27, 2010	December 15-December 25, 2010	Late Contributions (The "Late Contributions Report" is for reporting contributions received from any person or entity that aggregates more than \$500 and for reporting contributions made to candidates that aggregates more than \$500 during the period of fourteen calendar days through four calendar days prior to the <u>Special Election</u> . Late Contributions must also be reported on the Final Special Election Period Report. <u>The report is not required if there are no Late Contributions.</u>)

At the conclusion of the 2010 special election, Noncandidate Committees with a surplus or deficit must continue reporting with the Commission until the surplus has been disbursed or the deficit has been cleared. The first report is the Supplemental Report due on January 31, 2011, covering the period from December 30 through December 31, 2010.

The Noncandidate Committee may terminate its registration and reporting requirements by filing the "Request For Registration Termination" form, if the Noncandidate Committee has no surplus or deficit and the Commission approves the request.
