Old Business

Post public hearing statement on proposed amendments to Chapter 13-256-39, HAR, "Ocean Recreation Management Rules and Areas," which relates to vessel operations in Hanalei Bay and River, adoption of new Chapter 13-256-71, 13-256-72, 13-256-73 and 13-256-77, HAR, which implements the Kaneohe Bay Master Plan per HRS §200-39. Follow up on proposed adoption of new Chapter 17-1443, HAR, "State-Approved Feeding Assistant Training Program," which establishes requirements for State approved feeding assistant training programs in nursing homes; 17-1444, HAR, "Nurse Aide Training and Competency Evaluation Program," which establishes requirements for State-certified nurse aide training and competency evaluation programs; and 17-1445, HAR, "Recertification of Nurse Aides in State-Licensed or State-Certified Health Care Settings," which establishes standards for certified nurse aides in State-licensed or State-certified health care settings who choose to be recertified or whose recertification is required by their employers.
