- \$14 million is available
- Applications must be submitted by the State
- Program Categories are: Clean Cities, Codes & Standards, Rebuild America, Building America Federal Energy Management Program, Solar Technology, State Wind Energy Support, Distributed Energy and Electric Reliability, and Biomass.



State Energy Program Cont'd

- Cost Sharing is a mandatory factor for some of the Program Categories
- Application Due Dates – Multiple Due Dates for respective program categories
- Rebuild America and FEMP applications are due on March 24, 2004
