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


The trend of slower growth since 1950 was REVERSED in 2000






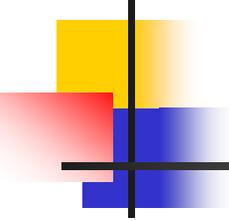
Figure 1. Percent Change in Resident Population for the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico: 1990 to 2000

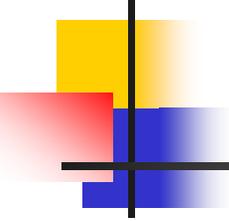




The Baby Boom Population


- Baby Boomers – persons born from 1946 to 1964 reached the ages of 36 to 54 years in 2000.
- The most rapid increase in size of any age group was the 49% jump in the population of 45 to 54 year-olds. This increase to 37.7 million in 2000 was fueled by the first baby boomers entering into this age group.
- The percentage of Baby Boomers in Hawaii was comparable to the nation.











Hawaii Median Age: Race Alone & Hispanic





Hawaii Population by Age and Sex

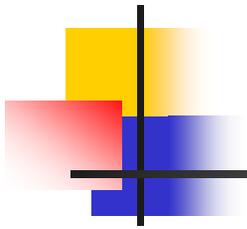

Office of Management and Budget

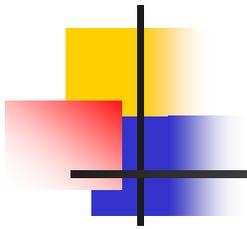
- 1997: Revised standards for collecting data on race and ethnicity

Major Changes

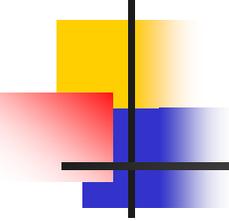
- Spanish/Hispanic/Latino asked before race
- Respondents could select more than 1 race
- American Indian and Alaska Native combined
- Asian & Pacific Islander category split:
 - Asian
 - Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander



Race and Ethnicity Tabulation Categories

- In some tabulations, race data will be shown for 63 categories
- In other tabulations race will be collapsed and shown as
 - * Race alone categories
 - * A two or more race category
 - * Race alone or in combination with one or more race
- Data for Hispanic or Latino

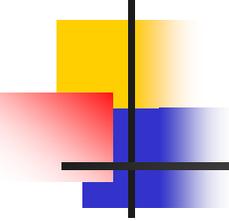
