On July 1, 2008, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,287,481.

On July 1, 2009, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,295,178.

52 births per day

27 deaths per day

11 more people moving into the State of Hawaii from foreign countries than those moving out of the State of Hawaii to foreign countries per day

15 more people moving out of the State of Hawaii to other states in the U.S. than those moving into the State of Hawaii from other states per day

7 births per day

4 deaths per day

1 more person moving out of the County of Hawaii to other states in the U.S. than those moving into the County of Hawaii from other states per day

On an average, between July 1, 2008 and July 1, 2009, there was an increase of 13 people per day:

37 births per day

19 deaths per day

8 more people moving into the City and County of Honolulu from foreign countries than those moving out of the City and County of Honolulu to foreign countries per day

12 more people moving out of the City and County of Honolulu to other states in the U.S. than those moving into the City and County of Honolulu from other states per day
