



Notice of Construction of Ethanol Production Facility

Act 289, Session Laws of Hawaii 2000, requires ethanol producers to provide written notice of intention to begin construction of a "qualifying ethanol production facility" (i.e. a facility eligible for the ethanol production facility investment tax credit) prior to facility construction. The information is to be provided to the Department of Taxation and the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, and shall identify the facility owner, facility location, facility production capacity, anticipated production start date, and the facility owner's contact information. This information shall be available for public inspection and dissemination.
