Development and Opportunities in Guangdong Province: *Featuring Wan Qingliang, Vice-Governor of Guangdong Province*



Vice-Governor Wan Qingliang will talk about the current economic situation in Guangdong Province, China. He will also give an overview of new initiatives in the province and Guangdong's role in the global market.

Vice-Governor Wan Qingliang started his civil service since 1984 in Meizhou City which situates in the east part of Guangdong. He served as Chairman of Guangdong Youth Federation from 2000-2003. In 2003, he was elected as Mayor of Jieyang City in Guangdong and was appointed as Secretary of the CPC Jieyang City Committee the next year. In January 2008, he was elected as Vice-Governor of Guangdong Province by the People's Congress of Guangdong Province.

He has an MBA from the South China University of Technology.
