

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING
THE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS DENTAL LICENSURE
EXAMINATION AND DENTAL HYGIENE LICENSURE EXAMINATION

DENTISTS

Pursuant to Act 72, Session Laws Hawaii, 2007, the examination for dental licensure in Hawaii is the American Board of Dental Examiners ("ADEX") dental licensure examination ("ADLEX"). Applicants for dental licensure can register with the Central Regional Dental Testing Service, Inc. ("CRDTS") to take the ADLEX. You may contact CRDTS at www.crdts.org. In addition, the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners, Inc. ("NERB") also administers the ADLEX, and they can be contacted at www.nerb.org.

DENTAL HYGIENISTS

The examination for dental hygiene licensure in Hawaii is the American Board of Dental Examiners ("ADEX") dental hygiene licensure examination ("ADHLEX"). Applicants for dental hygiene licensure can register with CRDTS at www.crdts.org to take the ADHLEX. In addition, an applicant who has taken and passed a state or regional examination after February 1, 2005 to June 9, 2006 shall be deemed to have met the Board's examination requirement for dental hygiene licensure.

Please be aware that the ADLEX and ADHLEX are being administered on a military facility, and access to and use of such facility are subject to federal authority. By submitting an application to take the ADLEX or ADHLEX, the candidate acknowledges and agrees that the ADLEX and/or ADHLEX may need to be postponed or cancelled without warning because of inaccessibility to the facility as determined by federal authorities.
