

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING THE INTERN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (IDP)

At its annual meeting in June 2008, NCARB approved changes to the IDP requirements. The "Six-Month Rule" was adopted and is designed to improve both the accuracy of reporting and the overall IDP experience. Under the new rule, interns will be required to report training units earned of intervals of no more than six months. However, they can submit reports more often – weekly or monthly – if they wish. All training units must be submitted electronically within two months of completion of each reporting period. Extensions will be given for birth or adoption of a child, active military duty, and serious medical conditions.

The rule will go into effect on July 1, 2009 for interns that begin an NCARB Record on or after that date and on July 1, 2010 for all interns.
