The Varsity program for teens in grades 9-12 and Junior Varsity program for teens in grades 6-8 complement any school curriculum and can be used as an after-school activity. This program is appropriate for public and private schools, homeschools, alternative schools as well as clubs and youth organizations.

VARSIY PROGRAM OVERVIEW

LifeSmarts helps students learn about their consumer rights and responsibilities and develop marketplace smarts. LifeSmarts is open to students in public, private, charter, home or alternative schools, community organizations, groups, clubs, or classes. Varsity teams must be in grades 9-12 and must submit a release form to participate at in-person competitions.

Teams are formed under the guidance of an adult coach/teacher that must register with the NCL through www.lifesmarts.org. A team consists of one coach and five team members. Teams first compete in the online competition, independently completing three levels of 20 questions in the following categories:

Consumer Rights & Responsibilities • Personal Finance • Health & Safety • Technology • Environment

Schools and organizations may enter more than one coach in the competition. Coaches may have multiple teams but only one team from each school or organization may qualify for the state competition. Qualifying teams in the varsity program will advance to the state in-person competition. The winning team will be eligible to represent Hawaii at the national competition.

Coaches have access to useful tools: TeamSmarts monthly team activity, LifeSmarts U's virtual classroom, pre-test and post-test scores to assess students' learning, on-line lessons, practice rounds of competition, scavenger hunts, fast facts, a question of the day calendar and much more.
