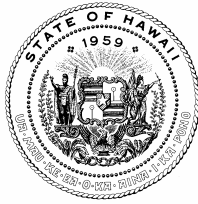

MEMORANDUM

TO: All Interested Parties
FROM: Real Estate Commission
RE: Proposed Rulemaking – Chapter 99, Hawaii Administrative Rules

The Commission is initiating the rulemaking process to implement certain portions of Chapter 467, Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”). In this regard, the Commission is soliciting comments on existing rules and proposals for new rules.

The current rulemaking process is intended to update Chapter 99 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules (“HAR”), as necessary, and to draft new rules to implement Chapter 467, HRS. The rulemaking process is limited to clarifying and implementing the real estate licensing law as it currently exists. Any changes to the law itself must be done through legislation, not through the rulemaking process.

The Commission will consider appropriate comments or suggestions regarding any updates to or proposals for HAR Chapter 99 as they relate to the real estate salesperson and broker licenses. Please provide all written comments and proposals, with written justifications, to the Commission by close of business Tuesday, August 31, 2010. They may be directed to:
