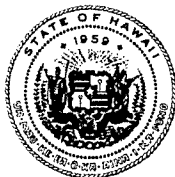

Dear West Hawaii Beneficiary:

The upcoming Community Consultation Series is an opportunity for you to discuss the following draft proposals with the Department and offer your suggestions:

- Land Acquisitions: Act 14, SpSLH 1995, authorizes the Department to negotiate the acquisition of public land from the State of Hawaii in order to restore the Hawaiian home lands trust. A proposed list of 1,100 acres has been compiled for review and discussion.
- Draft Energy Policy: In order to help native Hawaiians and the trust achieve energy self-sufficiency and sustainability, the Department has formulated a draft Energy Policy. Key objectives and activities will be covered and discussed.
- West Hawaii Land Uses: Review and discuss proposed amendments to the use of Hawaiian home lands at Kalaoa and Kealahou in West Hawaii.

The meeting will be followed by a 30-day period for you to provide any comments or suggestions by December 24, 2008, either by mail or email at dhhl.planning@hawaii.gov. The record of comments received will be transmitted to the Hawaiian Homes Commission with staff recommendations for their regular meeting on February 24, 2008.
