Vocational Education Scholarship

The Hawai'i Community Foundation is pleased to launch a new scholarship program for the 2006-2007 academic year. Vocational education describes certification or degree programs designed to teach students skills for a specific segment of employment. Programs are available statewide, mainly through the University of Hawai'i Community College system and other smaller, private institutions. Vocational education programs include culinary arts, auto repair, diesel mechanics, cosmetology, computer graphics, and assistive medical technology.

Vocational scholarships are made possible through the following funds at the Hawai'i Community Foundation:

Scholarship Terms and Amounts

If awarded, students will receive \$500 per semester to be used toward tuition, books, fees, or supplies. Scholarship checks will be mailed directly to the financial aid office and are disbursed upon verification of enrollment. Students are eligible for the vocational education scholarship for a maximum of two academic years or four semesters.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be Hawai'i residents enrolled in a vocational degree program in Hawai'i. For the 2006-2007 academic year, scholarships will be available for students enrolled in vocational programs at the following community colleges: **Hawai'i (HAW), Honolulu (HCC), Kapi'olani (KCC), Kaua'i (KAU), Leeward (LCC), or Maui (MCC) Community College.**

* *Applicants who meet the criteria for the Jackman or Hew-Shinn fund may attend a licensed and accredited school in the state of HI and the mainland U.S.*

** *The Department of Hawaiian Homelands will contact eligible applicants for genealogical verification.*

Application Requirements

Applicants must submit the application along with a **personal statement** addressing the following points:

- 1) Personal background and interests
- 2) Describe the vocational program you plan to pursue
- 3) What are your career goals?
- 4) Anything else that would demonstrate that you are a worthy scholarship candidate

Applicants must also include a **letter of recommendation** from someone such as a teacher, counselor or mentor in support of your application for the Vocational Education Scholarship. The letter must be written within the last six months.

+Applicants for the Arthur Jackman Memorial Fund are required to submit either the Student Aid Report (SAR) or HCF financial form. Request form at 1-888-731-3863 or download form at www.hawaiicommunityfoundation.org. To receive an SAR, you must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

If you are awarded a vocational education scholarship, a progress report and grade transcript will be required in order to continue your scholarship beyond the first year or term.
