Revised information about Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD) transition of behavioral health services to QUEST health plans

Summary

Department of Human Services (DHS) and Department of Health (DOH) have decided to delay the transition of Support for Emotional and Behavioral Development (SEBD) services for children and adolescents (ages 3 through 20) that are currently being provided by the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD).

Effective January 1, 2011, the QUEST health plans will be required to ensure that all of the services CAMHD offers are available by contracting with CAMHD or other providers. The QUEST health plans are strongly encouraged to contract with CAMHD to allow continuity of care.

DHS and DOH shall update the community on the status of health plans contracting with CAMHD in September 2010.
