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The DD/MR waiver program provides home and community-based care for persons with developmental disabilities and mental retardation who would otherwise receive such services in an Intermediate Care Facility for persons with mental retardation (ICF/MR).

The goal of this program is to reduce and prevent unnecessary institutionalization by providing home and community-based services at a cost less than or equal to institutionalization.

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## **Eligibility Requirements**

The person must:

- Be Medicaid eligible (Parents' income NOT considered when making determination)
- Be Intermediate Care Facility - Mentally Retarded (ICF-MR) level of care
- Choose to receive home and community-based services as an alternative to institutional placement

This program serves all ages.

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## **Services**

Persons in the DD/MR Waiver and their families can choose from the services below to design a package that meets their specific needs. They can also choose the waiver providers with whom they wish to work.

- Assistive Devices
- Chore Services
- DDMR Emergency Services
- Environmental Modifications
- Home Delivered Meals
- Non-Medical Transportation
- Personal Assistance/Habilitation

- CMU 1:** Hawaii Kai, Kahala, Kaimuki through Kalihi/Kapalama/ airport; this includes zip codes: **96814, 96815, 96816, 96821, 96822, 96825, and 96826.**
- CMU 2:** Kapolei and Ewa Beach to Waianae; this includes zip codes: **96706, 96707 and 96792.**
- CMU 3:** Ewa Beach (Pohakapuna area below Ft. Weaver Road, Soda Creek/Gentry, West Loch Estates, old Ewa), Waipahu (excluding CT 87.01, and 88) including Kunia/Village Park, Waikele, Sea View/CrestView; this includes zip codes: **96706, 96759.**
