Approve an Amendment with the Department of the Navy for the Renewal of a License for Nonfederal Use of Real Property and for Acceptance of an Environmental Condition of Property at Aiea Bay State Recreation Area, Aiea, Oahu, Tax Map Key (1)9-9-4:2 & 6 portions

BACKGROUND:

In 1993, a license agreement No. N6274293RP00066 (License) was executed with the Department of the Navy to use three acres of federal property at Aiea Bay for public park purposes between May 1, 1993 and April 30, 1998. Since that time, two amendments extending the License for two five-year periods until April 30, 2008 were executed. The map attached as Exhibit A indicates the location of the subject area.

The subject submittal requests the Board approval to renew the License until April 30, 2013. In May 2008, the Navy completed an environmental study which determines the environmental condition of the premises is suitable for the purpose. The Navy requests the study be incorporated into the License. Staff has reviewed the study and has no objection to the request.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board




