Under Chapter 180, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the governance of each Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) is placed in the hands of five directors, two of whom are appointed by the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) at the recommendation of the District and three of whom are elected by the land occupiers of the District. Where directors are elected, the Board must certify the election. Directors serve for a term of three (3) years.


The following individual has been duly elected to serve as a director of the Waikaea SWCD for a term ending June 30, 2012:

That the Board certify the election of George Mikami to serve as a director of the Waikaea Soil and Water Conservation Districts for the term specified.



** Chapter 180, Hawaii revised Statutes, Section 180-1, provides that each person, firm or corporation shall have one vote provided, however, that each land occupier of more than 100 acres shall be entitled to one vote for each 100 acres. Land occupiers are either tenants of owners or both. Twenty-five (25) or more votes are needed to nominate a director. A land occupier may sign more than one petition.
