Subject: Approval for a three month extension on a grant-in-aid agreement with
Kauai Planning & Action Alliance, Inc. (Contract No. 57874)

Kauai Planning & Action Alliance, Inc. (KPAA) was appropriated a \$1,225,000 CIP grant-in-aid under Act 213, SLH 2007, to provide trail restoration and reconstruction work on the first two miles from Ke'e Beach to Hanakapi'ai Beach at Na Pali Coast State Wilderness Park, and to rebuild the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) Camp at Koke'e State Park. The Division of State Parks contracted with KPAA, a non profit organization, on September 1, 2008. The organization has requested a three month extension, from December 31, 2010 to March 31, 2011, to complete the project. The Division of State Parks respectfully requests approval for a three month time extension.

The Division of State Parks would also like to amend the contract to allow any future time extensions to be approved by the Chairperson only, on behalf of the State.

RECOMMENDATIONS: That the Board:

1. Authorize a three month time extension on the grant-in-aid agreement with the Kauai Planning & Action Alliance, Inc. and authorize the Chairperson to sign the necessary documents and other non-substantive supplemental agreements pertaining to this project; and
2. Authorize the amendment of the grant-in-aid agreement with Kauai Planning & Action Alliance, Inc. to allow the Chairperson to approve any future extensions of the time of performance under this agreement.
