Administrative Enforcement Action for Violation of Hawaii Administrative Rule, Section 13-231-26, Use of a Vessel as a Place of Principal Habitation, Ala Wai Small Boat Harbor, to the Following Individuals: Robert O'Donoghue, John Morton (Marjorie Coleman – Owner of Vessel), Donald Krispin (Jonathan Alexander – Owner of Vessel), Patrick Kirkland (Sierra Masters – Owner of Vessel), Walter Kelley, Maurice Rosete and Minako Hiyashi, Robert Mathews and Troy Sunderland, Robert Jeralds and Starrlynn Honeycutt (Yang Suh – Owner of Vessel), Dean Powell, Troy Lynch, Jonathan White (David Stewart – Owner of Vessel)

STATUTORY AUTHORITY:

Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) §§ 200-9 and 200-14.5

BACKGROUND and DISCUSSION:

HRS, Section 200-9(b), states, “(b) Vessels used for purposes of recreational boating activities that are also the principal habitation of the owners shall occupy no more than one hundred twenty-nine berths at Ala Wai boat harbor and thirty-five berths at Keehi boat harbor, which is equal to fifteen per cent of the respective total moorage space that was available as of July 1, 1976, at the Ala Wai and Keehi boat harbors.”

Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), §13-231-26(a)(1), states, “(a) A vessel owner who holds a valid regular mooring permit issued by the department authorizing the owner to moor the owner’s vessel in Ala Wai or Keehi boat harbor may use that vessel as a place of principal habitation if the owner has applied for and secured:

(1) A principal habitation permit;”

Over the years, staff has continued to receive complaints that individuals are using vessels as their place of principal habitation within the Ala Wai and Keehi small boat harbors without obtaining the proper permits and at times exceeding the allowable number set in the HRS.

Staff has made numerous attempts to address this issue that include verbally notifying the vessel owners of the statute and rules, writing letters, and conducting night inspections in order to verify the allegations. Due to the limited resources and staff time, this approach seems to be effective in the short term but over time the unwanted behavior returns and staff has to start the process all over again.

In order to address this issue on a more permanent basis, staff devised a plan to document whether a person was actually using a vessel as a place of principal habitation without a valid principal habitation permit. Since verbal warnings were having little to no effect with changing the behavior of people found to be residing on the vessel without a valid permit, it was decided that the matter would be brought before the Board for administrative enforcement action.

The plan involved Staff informing individuals suspected of using a vessel as a place of principal habitation without a valid permit that they were in violation of the HRS and HAR, letters were then sent certified mail to the individuals suspected of using a vessel as a place of principal habitation (Exhibit A), and finally, staff, along with the Division of Conservation and Resource Enforcement (DOCARE) Officers, conducted a site visit that confirmed certain individuals were in fact on the vessels without valid permits (Exhibit B, DOCARE Investigation Report).

HAR, Section 13-231-6, authorizes the department to revoke a use permit for violation of the rules. HRS, 200-14.5, authorizes the Board to set, charge, and collect administrative fines and recover administrative costs. The citations are listed below for convenience.

**§13-231-6 Revocation of use permit.** (a) If after notice and lapse of a reasonable period of time, the permittee fails to remedy any breach of the duties, covenants or conditions of the permit or to desist from violating or permitting violation of these rules, the department may revoke the permittee's use permit. (b) In addition to subsection (a), the department may revoke a use permit for a deliberate misstatement or wilful failure to disclose any material fact in an application for a vessel number, documentation, registration of a vessel, or any of the use permits specified in section 13-231-3. [Eff 2/24/94] (Auth: HRS §200-10) (Imp: HRS §200-10)

**[§200-14.5] General administrative penalties.** (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, the board is authorized to set, charge, and collect administrative fines and to recover administrative fees and costs, including attorney's fees and costs, or bring legal action to recover administrative fines and fees and costs, including attorney's fees and costs, or payment for damages or for the cost to correct damages resulting from a violation of subtitle 8 of title 12 or any rule adopted thereunder. Each day or instance of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

(b) For violations involving pollution of the waters of the State, the administrative fine shall be as follows:

- (1) For a first violation or a violation beyond five years of a previous violation, a fine of not more than \$10,000;
- (2) For a second violation within five years of a previous violation, by a fine of not more than \$15,000; and
- (3) For a third or subsequent violation within five years of the last violation, by a fine of not more than \$25,000.

(c) For all other violations the administrative fine shall be as follows:

- (1) For a first violation or a violation beyond five years of a previous violation, a fine of not more than \$5,000;
- (2) For a second violation within five years of a previous violation, by a fine of not more than \$10,000; and
- (3) For a third or subsequent violation within five years of the last violation, by a fine of not more than \$15,000.

(d) Any criminal action against a person for any violation of subtitle 8 of title 12 or any rule adopted thereunder shall not preclude the State from pursuing civil legal action to recover administrative fines, fees and costs, or damages against that person. Any civil legal action to recover administrative fines, fees and costs, or damages for any violation of subtitle 8 of title 12 or any rule adopted thereunder shall not preclude the State from pursuing any appropriate criminal action against that person. costs, or damages recovered by the department under this section shall be deposited in the boating special fund. [L 1999, c 41, §1]


Staff believes that unless there are consequences for violating the HRS and HAR people do not have an incentive to abide by the rules or the direction of Harbor Staff. In order to send a strong message and curb this continued violation of the rules, the recommendation from staff is to revoke the regular mooring permits issued to the vessel owners named above and issue a one thousand dollar fine (\$1,000.00) to those people listed above who were found on the vessel without a valid principal habitation permit and were not the registered owner of the vessel at the time of the incident.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the Board:

1. Find that an administrative infraction of HAR section 13-231-26 was committed and that the individuals listed above committed the infractions.
2. Revoke the regular mooring permits issued to the individuals named above and issue a one thousand dollar fine to those individuals found on the vessel without a valid permit and who were not the registered owners of the vessel at the time of the incident.



It has been brought to our attention that there may be people living and/or staying board vessels at the Ala Wai Boat Harbor in violation of Sections 13-231-26 and/or 13-231-28, Hawaii Administrative Rules, and section 200-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The Hawaii Administrative Rules limit the number of harbor resident permits issued at the Ala Wai Boat Harbor to 129. Currently there is a waiting list for harbor resident permits. Only the owner, co-owner, spouse of each, and their legal dependants may be issued a harbor resident permit. Any person who is living aboard a vessel without a harbor resident permit is in violation of Section 200-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and harbor rules and must immediately make other living arrangements. Anyone who desires to live on their vessel should submit an application to be placed on the waiting list for a harbor resident permit. Until they receive a permit, they may not live aboard their vessel. If anyone else is living aboard the vessel, they must immediately move off the vessel.

Tenants who do have a harbor resident permit may "stay aboard" and "vacation" aboard their vessel. Hawaii Administrative Rules define "stay aboard" as three or less days per calendar week not to exceed 60 days per calendar year. "Vacation" is defined as 4 or more days per calendar week, not to exceed 30 days per calendar year. Notice must be given to the Ala Wai Boat Harbor office, in writing prior, to anyone "staying aboard" or "vacationing" aboard their vessel. Midnight through 6:00 a.m. are the violation hours which require a harbor resident permit, stay aboard notice, or a vacation notice. With a harbor resident permit, stay aboard permit or vacation permit, only the owner, co-owner, spouse of each, their legal dependants and their non-paying guests while in the company of the owner may be aboard during the violation hours.

It has been brought to our attention that there may be people living and/or staying aboard vessels at the Ala Wai Boat Harbor in violation of Sections 13-231-26 and/or 13-231-28, Hawaii Administrative Rules, and section 200-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The Hawaii Administrative Rules limit the number of harbor resident permits issued at the Ala Wai Boat Harbor to 129. Currently there is a waiting list for harbor resident permits.
