**DLNR TO START SUMMER NU‘UANU RESERVOIR #4 CATFISH OPENING ON  
AUG. 1**

HONOLULU — The Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) announced today that it will start the summer fishing season for Nu‘uanu Reservoir #4 on Saturday, August 1.

“For many years, the Department has supported freshwater reservoir fishing and appreciates the support of the Honolulu Board of Water Supply, owner of the reservoir, in allowing us to manage this popular fishery.” said Laura H. Thielen, DLNR chairperson.

“We have found a way to continue this popular fishing activity -- despite the serious fiscal emergency facing the state -- by reducing the number of fishing sessions to one per day,” she said. “We thank the fishers for their understanding and patience as we make necessary adjustments to the fishing entry cards.

The season will start August 1, to allow staff time to reallocate available fishing dates to the 7,200 applicants. The Division of Aquatic Resources will maintain two fishing sessions each weekend.

Fishing entry cards will be mailed out once dates are set.

The season was originally scheduled to open on July 18.
