DEEP-SEA HANDLINE FISHING TRIP REPORT INSTRUCTIONS

Header

1. “**Licensee Name**” – Print your full name as it appears on your commercial marine license.
2. “**Commercial Marine License No.**” – Enter your commercial marine license number in the boxes.
3. “**Port of Landing**” – Print the name of the port or launch ramp where you land your catch or where you recover your vessel: e.g. Honokohau Harbor, Kewalo Basin, Hawaii Kai, etc. Enter port of landing even if you did not catch anything.
4. “**Vessel Name**” – Print the vessel’s name as registered with the State Division of Boating & Ocean Recreation or U.S Coast Guard. If you don’t have a vessel name, leave this line blank.
5. “**H.A. No.**” – Enter the State of Hawaii certificate number here if the vessel is registered with the State Division of Boating & Ocean Recreation.
6. “**USCG No.**” – Enter the U.S. Coast Guard document number here if the vessel is registered with the U.S. Coast Guard.
7. “**Trip Start Date**” – Enter trip start date in boxes (Month/Day/Year). Trip start date is the day you left port. **A trip report consists of multiple (3 or more) days of fishing.**
8. “**Trip End Date**” – Enter trip end date in boxes (Month/Day/Year). Trip end date is the day you returned to port. Complete this section even if you did not catch anything.

Fishing Effort

1. “**Day Fished**” – Enter day of the month fished (e.g., 1, 2...12...31), and **use a separate line for each day fished**. Enter day fished even if you did not catch anything and complete this fishing effort section.
2. “**Buoy or Area Fished or Transit**” – Print only one buoy identification letter(s) or enter one area code fished per line. **Use a separate line when buoy or area fished changes**. Refer to Commercial Fisheries Statistical Charts A-H. Enter buoy or area code fished even if you did not catch anything. When transiting and trolling to or from a destination, enter the word **Transit**. Transit is when a vessel is traveling from a port of departure to the first fishing area, or from one area to another, or when returning to a port of landing while **Trolling**. However, if the vessel stops to fish, or if fish are landed while underway; the buoy or area whichever is applicable must be reported like a normal fishing activity.

Fishing Effort Continued

3. “**Fishing Method**” – Enter a “**BF**” for Deep-sea Handline, “**IH**” for Inshore Handline, “**TL**” for Trolling lures or print other fishing method used (refer to fishing methods list). **Use another line when fishing method changes**.
4. “**Hours Fished Per Method/Area**” – Enter number of hours fished (soak time).
5. “**No. of Fishing Lines**” – Enter number of fishing lines used.
6. “**No. of Hooks Per Line**” – Enter average number of hooks per line for Deep-sea Handline, Inshore Handline, or when using a mainline with multiple hooks per line.
7. “**No Catch X**” – Enter an **X** in this box if you did not catch anything.

Catch

1. “**No. Landed**” – Enter the number landed under the listed species column.
2. “**Lbs. Landed**” – Enter the estimated number of pounds landed under the listed species column.
3. “**No. Lost**” – Enter only the number of fish lost to any type of predation, i.e. sharks, porpoise, etc. **Do not include lost fish with number or pounds landed.**
4. “**Print Species Name**” – Print name of species landed in the blank boxes and enter “**No. Landed**”, “**Lbs. Landed**” and “**No. Lost**” only to predation.
5. “**Other Species Landed or Lost and Released**” – If species is not listed in boxes, print species name in “**Species Name**” column and enter “**No. Landed**” and “**Lbs. Landed**”. For “**L = Lost**” and “**R = Released**”, print species name if not already printed and enter number in applicable “**L**” and “**R**” columns. **Lost** refers to fish that were lost to any type of predation, i.e. sharks, porpoise, etc. **Released** refers to fish that were landed and intentionally released dead or alive, or tagged and released. **Do not include lost or released fish with number or pounds landed.**

Bottom of Page

1. “**Number Lost to Predators**” – To the best of your knowledge, enter number of fish lost to **Sharks**, or if predator cannot be identified use **Unknown**. If predator can be identified, print predator name next to **Other**, and enter number of losses.
2. “**Comments to DAR**” – Print comments in this section, and use a blank sheet of paper if more space is needed.
3. “**PAGE__of__.**” – Enter the page number, and total number of pages. (Example: Page 1 of 2, Page 2 of 2, if a total of two fishing report forms were submitted.)
