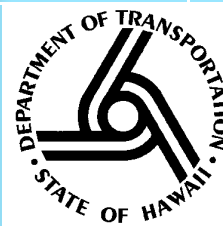

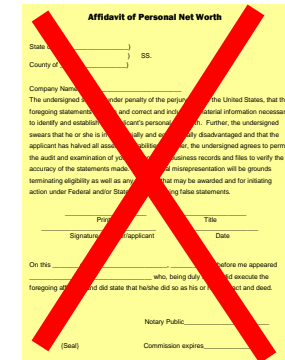

DBE forms & updates

As of December 2008, the HDOT/DBE office will no longer requires an Affidavit of Personal Net Worth (PNW) at the time of certification and recertification. However, the Affidavit of Certification is still required.

Recertification Application is now fillable and you will be able to save your document electronically. Prior to this, the form was available in only in hard copy and required to be typed or handwritten.



Affidavit of DBE Applicant is a new form created for out of state DBE certified an/or U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) certified firms. The purpose of this form is to reduce certification burdens on firms that are certified in their home state as a DBE and/or by the SBA, under its 8(a) or Small Disadvantaged Business Program, by accepting the application

Annual Change Affidavit— The Personal Financial Statement (PFS) is no longer required with the Annual Change Affidavit. However, there is a line on the Annual Change Affidavit for the owner's Personal Net Worth (PNW). The PNW is required for the purpose of determining continued DBE eligibility. As an economically disadvantaged owner (ie PNW less than \$750,000)
