NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD CONTRACT

Pursuant to Section 84-15 (a)(3), Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Department of Budget and Finance (hereinafter DB&F), hereby gives notice of its intent to enter into a Grant In Aid (GIA) Agreement with the Bishop Museum, a Hawaii non-profit corporation, in accordance with and pursuant to Chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Funds for the GIA are authorized pursuant to Act 213, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007. The Bishop Museum is the specified awardee of the GIA. The Museum will provide student visit and outreach programs that primarily benefit Hawaii's children and teachers in the public education system.

Mr. Timothy E. Johns, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Bishop Museum will execute the GIA Agreement on behalf of the Bishop Museum. Mr. Johns is a member of the State of Hawaii Board of Land and Natural Resources.

The term of the GIA Agreement is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2009 subject to the availability, approval, and allotment of funds for fiscal years 2007-2008 and 2008-2009. Act 213, SLH 2007 appropriated \$450,000 for each year of the 2007-2009 fiscal biennium.
