### **Filing of Candidates' Financial Interests Disclosure Statements for State Elective Office; Late Filers; Delinquent Filers**

The deadline established by state statute (HRS §84-17(b)), Hawaii Revised Statutes, for candidates for state elective office to file a candidates' disclosure of financial interests statement with the Hawaii State Ethics Commission was Monday, August 30, 2010. The candidates' disclosure of financial interests statement calls for information concerning sources of income, business interests, debts, real property interests, and officerships, directorships, or trusteeships in businesses. A total of 218 candidates filed their candidates' disclosure of financial interests statements by the statutory deadline.

The public is invited to review copies of the candidates' disclosure of financial interests statements at the Hawaii State Ethics Commission's office, 1001 Bishop Street, American Savings Bank Tower, Suite 970, Monday through Friday between 7:45 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Copies are also available at 5¢ per page.

The Hawaii State Ethics Commission did not receive, prior to the statutory filing deadline, a candidates' disclosure of financial interests statement from the following candidates:

\*Note: The candidates' disclosure of financial interests statements of John S. Carroll, Jon Riki Karamatsu, Karen L. Awana, Thomas Cerizo, and Dwight D. Synan were received after the deadline.

Section 84-17(j), Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the Hawaii State Ethics Commission to release to the public a list of the names of candidates who failed to file a candidates' disclosure of financial interests statement by the statutory deadline. Section 84-17(j), Hawaii Revised Statutes, also requires the Commission to assess a \$25 late filing penalty fee against candidates who have not filed their forms by the statutory deadline.

Chapter 84, HRS, requires candidates for the Office of Hawaiian Affairs trustee positions to file their candidates' disclosure of financial interests statements twenty days before the general election. For this reason, the filing deadline for the position of trustee of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is Wednesday, October 13, 2010.
