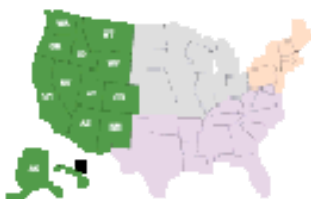

State Export Internship Opportunity

The Hawaii State Department of Agriculture, in cooperation with WUSATA, is seeking candidates for a State Export Internship.

Through many potential activities, the individual will have the opportunity to work on projects related to the promotion and recruitment of companies for domestic and international events as well as organization of export seminars, webinars and similar activities. Opportunities also exist to conduct market research and contribute to the development of marketing materials for internal and external use.

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to: 1) recruiting for generic activities and branded program, 2) research, 3) education & outreach, 4) marketing, 5) activity development, 6) assist activity management (not travel to but administrative help), 6) trade leads 8) other efforts assisting companies in international support activities related to WUSATA Market Access Program (MAP), and 9) Updating the state exporters database and contact lists.

To qualify, the candidate must be a college/university student and must be a U.S. citizen or have a visa that permits individuals to work. Preference is given to candidates enrolled in a Hawaii college or university and pursuing a degree in international marketing, marketing, agriculture, business or a related field. Strong writing skills are required as are strong interpersonal skills and analytical competencies. Proficiency in Microsoft Office is required.

The intern will be paid \$11.00/hour for a maximum 19 hours of work per week.

Opportunity to work on projects that help Hawaii companies export agricultural products grown, processed or manufactured in Hawaii.

Contribute to the preparation of materials that will serve as valuable tools for Hawaii companies interested in exporting.

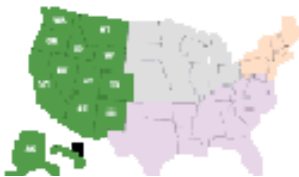
