Let stand 30 seconds or longer if noted. Wipe with a wet sponge or cloth and rinse with water. No scrubbing required. For heavily soiled surfaces, preclean surface before disinfecting. Refill only with this product.

CONTACT TIME: Wet surface and let stand 2 minutes.
