HOW TO APPLY: • SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE AND BEFORE EACH SPRAY. • Turn can upside down to use. • Hold can at arm's length, 1 to 2 feet from weed. • Point can at weed. • Press spray button briefly, to cover the center of the weed with foam. • **DO NOT press button with can in upright position.** • Do not overspray • If certain tough weeds are not killed within 4 weeks, re-apply.
WHEN TO APPLY: Apply when weeds are actively growing. Spray when air is calm. For best results, apply during warm, sunny weather (above 60° F).
