SPRAYER TYPE – Mixing and Measuring

FOR PUMP STYLE TANK SPRAYERS To make one gallon of spray:
 1. Pour 1/2 fl. oz. (1 tablespoon) of the liquid concentrate.
 2. Dilute with 1 gallon of water.
 3. Close sprayer and shake well before applying.



FOR DIAL-STYLE HOSE-END SPRAYERS Dilution rate: 1/2 fl. oz. per gallon
 Lawns and around homes: 3 fl. oz. per gallon
 (1 tablespoon = 1/2 fl. oz.)
 1. Fill sprayer jar with enough concentrate to cover area to be treated.
 2. Close sprayer and set dial.
 3. Attach sprayer to hose and apply.
 4. To avoid contact with the treated area, begin by spraying area farthest from faucet walking backwards as you spray.



FOR CONCENTRATE PLUS WATER HOSE-END SPRAYERS Dilution rate: 1/2 fl. oz. per gallon
 Lawns and around homes: 3 fl. oz. per gallon
 (1 tablespoon = 1/2 fl. oz.)
 1. Pour concentrate into sprayer jar to the required fluid ounce level.
 2. Add the appropriate amount of water to the gallons level.
 3. Replace sprayer top and shake well before applying.
 4. To avoid contact with the treated area, begin by spraying area farthest from faucet walking backwards as you spray.



FOR BEST RESULTS

Do not water the foliage within one hour after applying. To avoid serious damage to plants, eliminate pests early in the season before they multiply.
