

Reptile Spray kills mites and other reptile parasites.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE.

1. Spray directly on reptile, but not to excess (runoff) and all areas where mites may hide. Avoid spraying eyes and facial areas. Alternatively, spray *Reptile Spray* onto a cloth and wipe on reptile.
2. Reapply as often as necessary, but not more often than at 3-day intervals.
3. Do not treat snakes for at least 6 hours after shedding their skin.

Reptile Spray can be used to clean surfaces of terrariums and other habitats. Spray surfaces with this product and wipe with clean cloth. Rinse and dry surfaces before reintroducing reptile to habitat. **NOT FOR USE ON AMPHIBIANS SUCH AS FROGS AND/OR TOADS.**

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.
