

FIRST AID	
<b>If In Eyes</b>	Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
<b>If on Skin or Clothing</b>	Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice.

CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness of pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60".

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 - 17 fluid ounces of CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pools, add 6-11 fluid ounces of CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 - 4 fluid ounces of CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 1 - 2 fluid ounces of CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain or pond, add 0.6 - 1.1 fluid ounces of CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 - 0.4 fluid ounces of CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools, which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 6 - 10 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of the swimming season, pools have some visible algae growth, add 12 - 17 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algicide throughout the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix CLEARVIEW "POLYPOWER 60" with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep container closed when not in use.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
