

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not spray on or near exposed food. FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. **IF IN EYES** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
