

Use Antibacterial Revolution Wipes to clean and disinfect hard non-porous surfaces of gym equipment, exercise machines, wrestling mats and Non-critical medical equipment surfaces: examining tables. For use in hospitals, schools, health clubs and daycare centers.

**TO OPEN PACKAGE:** Slowly open seal. Remove towelette as needed. To retain moisture, reseal bag by firmly pressing seal back on the bag.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use as a diaper wipe or for personal cleansing. This is not a baby wipe! Do not flush in toilet. For plastic and painted surfaces, spot test on an inconspicuous area before use. Will not harm most surfaces: including acrylic, sealed fiberglass and vinyl. Do not use on unpainted wood.

**TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE:** Wipe surface with wipe. Let air dry. Discard used wipe in trash. Do not flush in toilet.

**TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT / VIRUCIDAL\* / MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL DIRECTIONS:**

Wipe surface with wipe until surface is visibly wet. Allow surface to remain wet for 4 minutes. Let air dry. If surfaces are extremely dirty, clean first with another wipe before disinfecting. Discard used wipe in trash. Do not flush. Rinse food contact surfaces with clean, potable water after disinfecting. Do not use to disinfect dishes, glassware or utensils.

For mold and mildew, Antibacterial Revolution Wipes will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, nonporous surfaces. Follow disinfection instructions. Repeat treatment every seven days, or more if new growth appears.

**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1 OR HBV OR HCV ON SURFACES / OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD / BODY FLUIDS.**

**Personal protection:** Clean-up must always be done wearing protective gloves, gowns, masks and eye protection.

**Cleaning procedure:** Blood and other body fluids containing HIV or HBV or HCV must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of Antibacterial Revolution Wipes. Antibacterial Revolution Wipes can be used for this purpose.

**Contact time:** Leave surface wet for 1 minute [60 seconds] for HIV-1. Use appropriate contact time as listed on label for all other viruses and bacteria claimed.

**Disposal of infectious material:**

Blood, body fluids, cleaning materials and clothing must be disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

This product is for use on hard non-porous surfaces not conducive to treatment by immersion or excess liquid against Avian Influenza A.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**FIRST AID**
