



## INFORMATION

Do it Best® Grass & Weed Killer is a nonselective ready-to-use herbicide that controls annual and perennial grasses, broadleaf weeds and sedges. Do it Best® Grass & Weed Killer can be used in flower beds, mulch beds, around trees and shrubs, vegetable gardens, along fences, sidewalks, walkways, patios, driveways, curbs, gutters, foundations and buildings where there is unwanted vegetation. Spray carefully. Avoid spray or drift onto desirable lawn grasses, shrubs or trees. Do it Best® Grass & Weed Killer can kill or damage all vegetation contacted.

## PRODUCT FACTS

**Kills:** All types of weeds and grasses

**Where to Use:** On and around driveways, gutters, curbs, walkways, gravel, patios or mulch beds, around flowers, trees and shrubs, in flower beds and vegetable gardens, other areas of yard, along fences and foundations, on wooded or vacant lots, in recreational areas, parks and sports facilities, around homes, buildings, cabins, lodges and camp sites.

**WHEN TO USE:** Use anytime weeds are actively growing and when the air is calm. For best results, apply when temperatures are above 60°F. Do not apply when rain is expected within 24 hours. Do it Best® Grass & Weed Killer starts working within hours. Most weeds and grasses will show signs of yellowing and wilting within 1 week and complete kill in 2 to 3 weeks for most weeds. Established weeds may require a repeat application.

**HOW TO USE:** This product is formulated for "spot" treatment of individual weeds and grasses around trees, shrubs, fences, walks, and in flower gardens. Avoid contact with desirable plants as injury will occur. Adjust the sprayer nozzle to a coarse spray. Position tip approximately 1 to 2 feet away from the target plant. Spray until foliage is wet, stopping just before the spray begins to drip or run off. Wait 7 days after last application to rake, till, or plant with seed or sod.

**IMPORTANT:** This product can injure or kill all vegetation contacted. Avoid drift onto desirable lawn grasses, trees and shrubs. If accidental spray contacts desirable vegetation, wash off immediately with water. Avoid mowing, cutting or otherwise disturbing treated vegetation for at least 7 days.

## WHEN TO REPLANT:

- All ornamental flowers, trees & shrubs as well as the following berries, fruits, vegetables and herbs may be planted 1 day after application: artichoke (Jerusalem), beans (all), beet greens, blackberry, blueberry, boysenberry, broccoli, Brussels sprout, cabbage (all), carrot, cauliflower, celery, chard (Swiss), chicory, collards, cranberry, currant, dewberry, elderberry, endive, gooseberry, horseradish, huckleberry, kale, kohlrabi, leek, lentil, lettuce, loganberry, mustard greens, okra, olallieberry, onion, parsley, parsnip, potato, radish, rape greens, raspberry (black and red), rhubarb, rutabaga, spinach, sweet potato, turnip and yams.
- The following fruits, vegetables and herbs may be planted 3 days after application: corn, cucumber, eggplant, garlic, gourds, melons (all), peas (all), peppers (all), pumpkin, squash (summer and winter), tomatillo, tomato (by seed) and watercress.
- Lawns may be planted 7 days after applications.
- Tomatoes from transplants and all berries, fruits, vegetables and herbs not previously listed may be planted 30 days after application.
- If used to control weeds around berries, wait 14 days after the last application before harvesting.

## STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store product in original container in a safe place away from direct sunlight. Keep from freezing.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. People and pets may enter treated areas after spray has dried.

**First Aid: If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

## Environmental Hazards
