SWIMMING POOLS

It is in a dry, free-flowing form. It kills bacteria, controls algae and destroys organic contaminants in pools.

HOW TO USE: Do not pre-mix this product. Use entire contents when opened.

Method for dosing directly into pool:

1. Add the recommended dosage of this product during evening hours while the filter pump is running.
2. When adding this product to your pool, broadcast the product evenly over a wide area in the deepest part of the pool.
3. If any granules settle to the bottom of the pool, use brush to disperse.

WATER BALANCE: For best product performance, swimmer comfort and crystal clear water, maintain the following water balance:

Follow label directions for each product and allow each product to dissolve and disperse before adding additional products to the pool. Use a reliable test kit that measures all these ranges.

Ultima® Swamp to Swim® Shock System: If you are experiencing a severe algae bloom, which has turned your pool green, **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® Shock System** can turn your pool sparkling blue again. This two-part system kills bacteria and algae that has invaded your pool and then makes it easy to vacuum out.

At the start of the season, or if a severe algae bloom occurs during the season, the pool can be treated and returned to its clear blue appearance within 24 hours by using **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® I** and **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® II** as part of the **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® Shock System**.

1. Add 2.6 lbs of **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® I** per 10,000 gallons of pool water. If any granules settle to the bottom of the pool, use brush to disperse to assist in helping it to dissolve.
2. Once **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® I** has completely been dispersed in the pool water, change valve to recirculate position and add 1.3 lbs **Ultima® Swamp to Swim® II** flocculent per 10,000 gallons of pool water through the skimmer.
3. Leave the system circulating for 1 hour then turn off the filter pump and allow to settle overnight.
4. The following day, change valve to vacuum position and vacuum the sediment to waste.

6. Return valve to filter position after pool has been vacuumed.
