PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid breathing spray. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

HAZARDS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: External use only. Use only on dogs and cats. May cause eye irritation. Take care not to spray in the animal's eyes or nose area. Do not use on kittens less than 3 lbs. or puppies less than 5 lbs. or under 8 weeks of age. Do not use on irritated skin. Individual sensitivities, while rare, may occur after using any pesticide product. If signs persist or become severe consult a veterinarian. Do not use this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing dogs or cats. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FIRST AID	
If in eyes:	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, and then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If swallowed:	Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything to an unconscious person.
If inhaled:	Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible. Call poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

SIDE EFFECTS

Monitor your pet after application. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your dog or cat with mild soap or shampoo and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs of individual animal sensitivity occur and persist, contact your veterinarian or call us at 1-800-999-0297. Have the product container or label with you when calling your veterinarian for advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. HOW TO APPLY:

Spray the entire body of the dog or cat applying from a distance of 5 to 10 inches. Ruffle the coat especially in long haired or densely coated animals. Apply against the lay of the hair; so that the product penetrates down to the skin. For head and eye area spray on cloth and rub gently into the animal's hair. Avoid spraying directly on the animal's eyes or nose. Make sure the entire coat of the animal is thoroughly covered. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after application.

1. The dog or cat should be standing or in a comfortable position for easy application.
2. Calculate the number of spray pumps based on the weight of the dog or cat. Your veterinarian or veterinary technician (nurse) can help with calculations using the charts below if needed.
3. Application charts for Dogs and Cats are shown below.
4. **Cats / Kittens:** Restrain (scruff) and apply the required number of sprays over the entire body of the cat.
Dogs / Puppies: Restrain (scruff) and apply the required number of sprays over the entire body of the dog, including the sides, abdomen, legs, shoulders, tail and neck.

As with any flea control product, wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly with soap and water after use.
