FIRST AID

Mop hard surface floors. Spray all floors and other aforementioned areas thoroughly using a smooth back and forth motion. Provide even treatment but do not soak the areas that you treat. If fleas reappear, repeat treatment or allow the product's residual effect to kill the newly emerged fleas.

KENNELS OR PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Apply HomeMD Maximum Defense™ Home and Carpet Spray thoroughly to infested areas including pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door sills, and localized areas of floor and floor covering where fleas, ticks and lice may be present. Old pet bedding should be removed and replaced with fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not spray surfaces where spotting, staining or discoloration would be objectionable.
