Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS ON CATS AND DOGS:

Wet the pet's coat with warm water. Do not apply shampoo around eyes. Apply shampoo on head and ears, then lather; repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. Let animal stand three to five minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure) then thoroughly rinse animal. Dry with a towel, or immediately repeat treatment on extremely dirty or scaly animals; otherwise do not reapply for 7 days. The pet will have a clean, lustrous coat, free of fleas and ticks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Simultaneously treat pet bedding and quarters with a product approved for premise treatment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Humans: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors and contact with eyes. Thoroughly wash with soap and water after use. **Animals:** Do not use on puppies or kittens less than 12 weeks of age. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, immediately consult a veterinarian.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If Inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. **If in Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL:** Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available.
