FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

SPILL OR LEAK

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE glasses, dishes, mugs, knives, food utensils and equipment, use the following procedures:

Scrape and then prewash with **SANITIZER CLEANER** solution (1 oz. or 2 Tbs. per quart of water) or other detergent or compatible cleaner. Rinse in potable water.

TO SANITIZE glasses, dishes, mugs, knives, food utensils and equipment, use the following procedures:

Sanitize in **SANITIZER CLEANER** solution (0.75 oz. or 1.5 level Tbs. per gallon of potable water (200 ppm)). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes of contact time specified by governing sanitary code.

NOTE: WHEN USED ON FOOD CONTACT PROCESSING EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS, AND ON OTHER FOOD CONTACT ARTICLES, FDA REGULATIONS REQUIRE ADEQUATE DRAINING BEFORE CONTACT WITH FOOD.

Solutions should be freshly prepared. Solutions should be tested during use to make sure the concentration does not drop below the recommended level. Keep in properly labeled containers to protect against contamination. Unused solutions should be discarded.
