DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Apply this product once every 30 days unless a retreatment is necessary. *If necessary, product can be reapplied at 8 or more days after the initial application. Do not use more than one tube per dog and do not retreat more than once per month. Do not get this product in dog's/puppy's eyes or mouth. Do not allow your dog/puppy to ingest this product.

Adams™ for Dogs Flea & Tick Spot On® works by application directly to the dog's/puppy's skin, not to the hair. When applying, use applicator device tip to push aside dog's/puppy's hair to allow direct application to the skin.

FOR MEDIUM SIZE DOGS/PUPPIES

To apply the treatment, use one disposable liquid tube with the applicator device.

1. OPEN Use finger scoop to lift open blue door.



2. LOAD To Load, place tube white side up into the open applicator with front of tube placed under tab on door. Ensure that tube fits securely in the applicator.



3. CLOSE Gently close the blue door and the tube will snap open.



4. APPLY The dog/puppy should be standing for easy application. To apply, use tip to part hair and get next to dog's/puppy's skin. Press round thumb pad on blue door once at each of three evenly placed spots between the shoulder and the base of the tail.



Do not apply an excessive amount of the solution at any one spot that could cause some of the solution to run off the side of the dog/puppy. Do not spread this product by hand over the dog/puppy. Although the dog's/puppy's skin and hair oils will distribute the application over the entire dog/puppy, brushing the dog/puppy 12-24 hours after treatment will help to distribute the material over the skin.

5. DISPOSE To dispose of empty tube, open blue door and drop empty tube into trash or offer for recycling if available. Close applicator device door and store in original package.



6. RETREATMENT *If necessary, product can be reapplied, but not sooner than 8 days after the initial treatment. Do not retreat more than once per month.

Note: Each package contains sufficient tubes for 3 applications.

Adams™ for Dogs Flea & Tick Spot On® is most effective when used as part of a total flea and tick management program. Use other Adams™ products registered for residential area control of these pests in conjunction with this treatment. Monthly treatments are required for optimal control and prevention of fleas.

The successive feeding activity of fleas on dogs/puppies may elicit a hypersensitivity skin disorder known as flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). Treatment of dogs/puppies with Adams™ for Dogs Flea & Tick Spot On® rapidly kills fleas and may reduce the incidence of this condition. Adams™ for Dogs Flea & Tick Spot On® is water resistant and remains efficacious following exposure to rainfall or swimming.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL: Pesticide Storage: Store tubes together in a cool area away from children and animals. **Liquid Tube Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse tube. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partially filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS – CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Repeated exposure to Etofenprox can cause skin irritation.

FIRST AID: If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 800-234-2269 for emergency medical treatment information.

Side Effects: Monitor your dog/puppy after application. Side effects may include signs of skin irritation such as redness, scratching, or other signs of discomfort.
