Uniformly blend with standard roofing granules at a rate of 10% by weight. For applications where algae growth is severe, uniformly blend with standard roofing granules at a rate not to exceed 20% by weight.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store and handle in a manner that will minimize the formation of dust.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
