

To repel insects listed on the front panel, first remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away. Point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. **Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not use under clothing. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overexposure.** Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. For chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Avoid contact with plastics such as eyeglass frames and such fabric as acetate rayon.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. This container may be recycled in one of the limited number of aerosol recycling centers in the country. Before recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. **DO NOT PUNCTURE!** If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.


