

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT & POINTED AWAY FROM FACE.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames except pilot lights. (Keep can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights). Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space (25 ft x 25 ft room with a standard 8 ft ceiling). Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.  **IMPORTANT:** Do not remain in the building during treatment and ventilate thoroughly (30 minutes) before reentry. Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

FOR TOTAL RELEASE: To lock valve in open position, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room on several layers of newspaper to prevent marring of surface. Leave treatment area at once and keep area closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air (30 minutes). Repeat application when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. (DO NOT PUNCTURE!) If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.




PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
