### FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:** Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. ### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skins, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling or before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

**OUTDOOR USES:** Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas and outdoor play areas.

**INDOOR USES:** Attics and anywhere nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed.

Kills insects and eliminates the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying. Kills any insects inside the nest, as well as any returning.

**For Control of Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Hornets and other listed insects; For Nests:** 1. Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active. 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath. 3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray. 4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked. 5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest. 6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

**To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies and Mosquitoes:** 1. Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed. 2. To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations, as well as along sills and ledges.

**Kills Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Mud Daubers and Hornets: To treat nests:** 1. Spray at sunrise or dusk when insects are least active. 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath. 3. Always hold can upright while spraying. 4. With wind at your back, aim actuator at the nest, and push button to spray. 5. Spray opening of nest until soaked. Then spray the rest of the nest. 6. Entrapping foam will remain on the nest to kill insects that return to the nest. 7. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

**Kills other insects, including Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies and Mosquitoes:** 1. Spray short 1-2 second bursts directly on insects. 2. For scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover the insect. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

**Use Tips:** 1. If windy, stand with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift. 2. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. 3. Rinse with water any desirable foliage that is contacted with spray.

**General Precautions and Restrictions:** Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in commercial food/feed processing, preparation, food/feed storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff. Do not make applications during rain. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack an crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses: (1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures; Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any areas like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles, as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

**Use Precautions:** 1. Avoid spraying desirable plants. Rinse with water any desirable foliage that is contacted with spray. 2. This product may stain vinyl, painted and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles, as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food. **Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling:** Do not puncture or incinerate! Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.

**If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
