DOWICIL 96 may be added at any point in the manufacturing cycle. The recommended rate for preservation of inks and latex paints is 0.04 to 0.2 lb per 100 lb of the formulation. The recommended rate for preservation of resin emulsions is approximately 0.1 lb per 100 lb of the formulation. For slurries recommended rates are 0.04 to 0.2 lb per 100 lb.
